## **Important Information**

- To ensure affordability for every family, The Ecclesial School scales shares of tuition according to a family's Percentage of Federal Poverty. We also provide additional sponsorship funds for families with multiple students enrolled at The Ecclesial School.
- The Percentage of Federal Poverty is determined according to guidelines set each year by the federal government. It takes into account a family's adjusted gross income and household size.
- Florida also uses a family's Percentage of Federal Poverty to prioritize recipients of Choice Scholarship funding.
